Mary was married to William Beebe, stonemason.

William is buried in a different section (K4).

His anti-church views may have played a major part in the location William wanted to be buried in, but his wife or children seemed to not hold the same views and buried their mother in consecrated ground.

PERSONAL.

The intimation of the death of Mrs Beebe, widow of the late Mr W Beebe senr, will be received with great regret by her many friends and acquaintances. The deceased lady passed away at her residence, Percival Street, Quarry Hill, yesterday afternoon, at the age of 68 years.

Her illness - an attack of inflammation of the lungs - was of a fortnight's duration, and she was attended by Drs Penfold and Atkinson. Mrs Beebe lived for nearly 50 years in Bendigo, and in the course of that lengthy period made a large number of close friends, who held her in the highest esteem. Her family, consisting of four sons and three daughters, are all well known, especially Messrs W and J Beebe. The deceased lady was born in England, and her husband predeceased her some 12 years ago.
