Death of a Chinaman.
Tip Kee (Lee Kie), a Chinese storekeeper, of Mundy Street died on Saturday night from diabetes. He was under the treatment of Dr Norris, and latterly also suffered from a carbuncle on the neck. Lee Kie was a very old resident of Bendigo. In the earlier days he was storekeeping in Bridge Street, and took a trip to China. When he returned some 15 years back, he started business in Mundy Street, continued to carry it on till his death. His agreeable nature made him well liked.
