Born: 15 Feb 1875 Sandhurst, Victoria, Australia

Died: 13 Aug 1945 Bendigo, Victoria, Australia

Buried: 14 Aug 1945

Locally born and raised, sole Heiress of her father's fortune at age 10. Lifetime Benefactress of Charitable Institutions and Organisations. Charitable Worker & Fundraiser.

The parents for Amy BAYNE were Celia Margaret (nee: Giles) and Joseph BELL.

They are both buried in the White Hills Cemetery.

Amy's mother Celia died in the year of her birth in 1875 aged 33.

Her father Joseph was a well-known reef miner and who amassed a large fortune but he died in 1885 aged 56, leaving a young Amy, an only child, a large fortune at the age of 10.

Amy married Harry Holmes (1st husband) who died in 1917. Her father-in-law was a major of Bendigo.

Amy later married Douglas Williamson BAYNE in 1923. Douglas died in 1930.

Amy is buried in a grave, marked by a magnificent monument, with both her husbands.
