18. WILLIAM CHARLES VAHLAND

Born: 2 Oct 1828 Nienburg an der Weser, Hanover, Germany

Died: 21 Jul 1915 Bendigo, Victoria, Australia

Date of Burial: 22 July 1915

Arrived in Melbourne in 1854

Renowned Architect of Bendigo who is recognised for designing the School of Mines, the Town Hall, and the Alexandra Fountain; Local Government Councillor; Carpenter; Miner; Winemaker

Located in Section H1

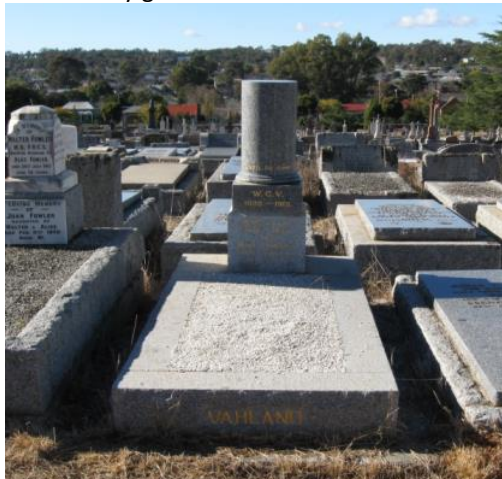
