23. SIR GILBERT JOSEPH CULLEN DYETT

First Bendigo born person to be Knighted. Awarded Companion of the Order of St. Michael & St. George 1927. Awarded Knight Bachelor 1934. Captain in the A.I.F. Gallipoli Veteran. First Federal President of Returned Sailors and Soldiers Imperial League (later R.S.L.) in 1919 and remained in office until 1946; Dominion President of the British Empire Service League 1921-1946. Victorian Trotting and Racing Association Secretary 1919-1949
