Obituary.

A very old and highly respected resident of Ironbark passed away last evening at his late residence, Webster Street, in the person of Mr Albert Boldt. He had been ailing from bronchitis and asthma for the last two years, but only took to his bed about a week ago.

The deceased gentleman, who was in his 67th year, was born in Strasbourg, Prussia, and came to the colony in 1854, arriving on Bendigo in the same year. Engaging in mining pursuits he was rewarded with success, and carried on extensive prospecting operations for a great many years. He was a very old member of the Forest Street Wesleyan Church, and at one time taught in the Sabbath School. He leaves a family of four sons (one of whom is a contractor under the City Council) and four daughters. The funeral will take place tomorrow to the Bendigo Cemetery.
