Notes for Ernest Henry Luecke and his wife Wilhelmina.

The location issue: section mapping has the grave for Louisa Luecke, daughter of Ernest & Wilhelmina, who died in 7/04/1868 and buried in 8/04/1868 aged 2 years in section B3.

And records then have Ernest Henry Luecke buried in this location (B3) when he died in 9/07/1903

and was buried in 11/07/1903. This is now an earthen grave.

When Wilhelmina was buried in 22/10/1912, it was in section A2 and a headstone was erected and it named Louisa, Ernest and Wilhelmina.

OBITUARY.

The death occurred at her son's residence, High Street, Golden Square, on Monday of Mrs Luecke, at the advanced age of 82 years. The deceased lady, who was a native of Germany, had resided in Victoria for 49 years.

The funeral took place yesterday to the Bendigo Cemetery, and was largely attended. The coffin bearers were Messrs E J Ryan, W Ryan, E Leucke, and J Ryan. The Rev Mr Leypoldt conducted an impressive burial service. The funeral arrangements were in the hands of Messrs Fizelle and Mulqueen. A family of six

children - one son and five daughters - all grown up, is left to mourn a sad loss.
