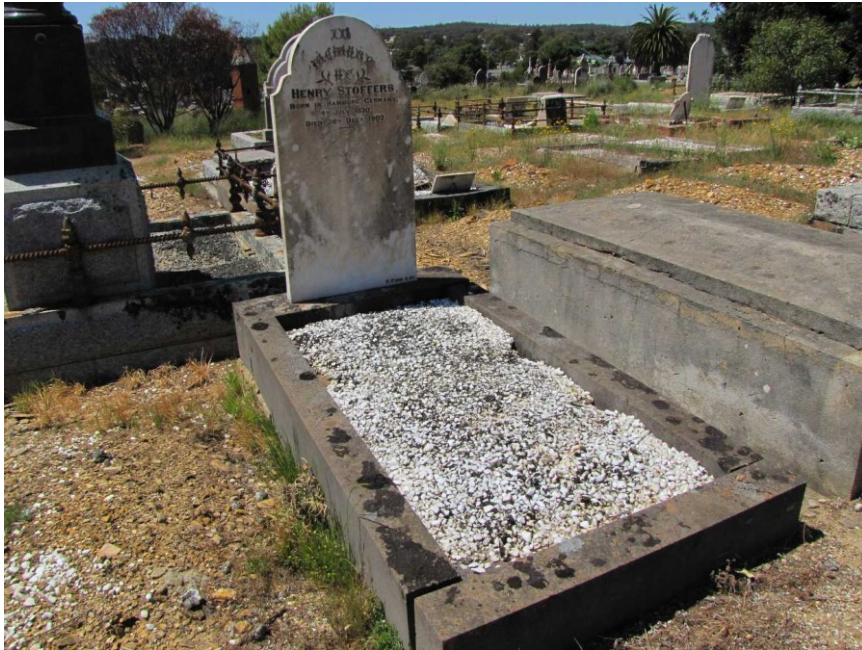


Bendigo Cemetery

MR HARRY STOFFERS

Mr Harry Stoffers, an old and much respected resident, died yesterday morning at the ripe age of 72. He arrived in Melbourne, from Hamburg, his native city, in the

fifties, and followed up many of the gold rushes in the early days. He came to Bendigo about 40 years ago and has resided here since.

For a considerable time he was a member of the stock exchange, and speculated with varying success, while for a number of years he carried on the tobacconist shop at the entrance to the Beehive Exchange, and was also lessee of several billiard rooms. He was a patriotic son of Fatherland, and will be much missed by many friends. He had been in failing health for some time. He was unmarried and his only relatives in Australia were a brother and sister residing in Melbourne and another brother in Perth.

The funeral takes place from the European Hotel, High Street, to the Bendigo Cemetery on Sunday at 10 am. Members of the stock exchange are invited to assemble at the Beehive at 9.45 am.
