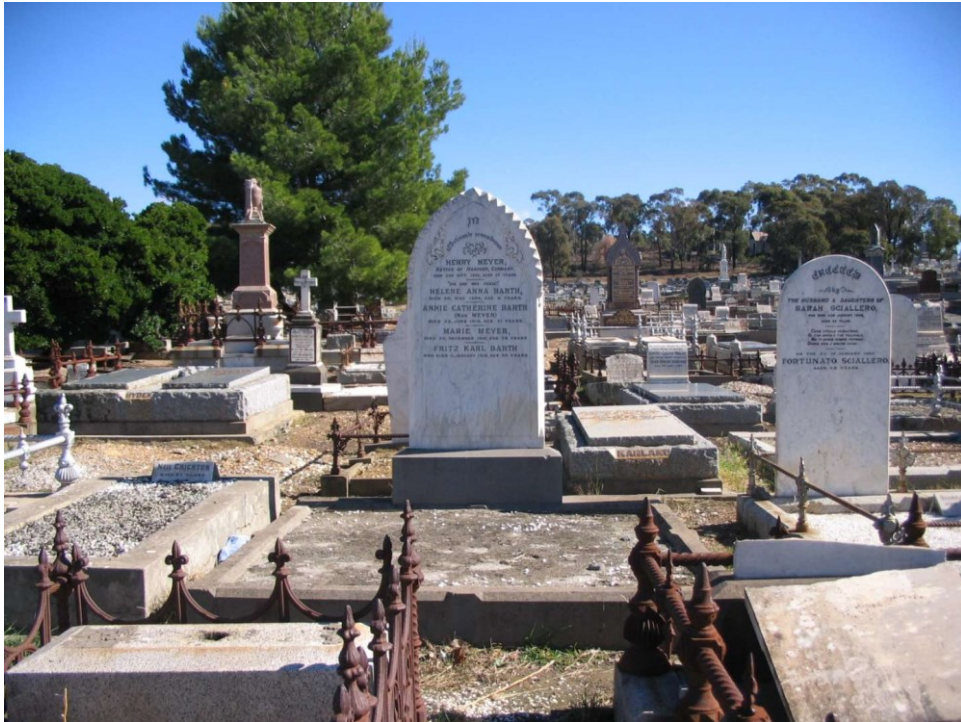

DEATH OF MR. HEINRICH MEYER.

Mr Heinrich Meyer, the well-known vigneron and proprietor of the Adventure Vineyard, expired at his residence, Sheepwash, yesterday. The deceased was an old and respected resident of the district, and his death will be deeply regretted by a wide circle of friends. The deceased gentleman was a member of the Bendigo Deutscher Verein. The funeral takes place today, the place of interment being the Sandhurst cemetery.

The funeral of the late Mr H Meyer, of Adventure Vineyard, Mandurang, took place yesterday afternoon and was largely attended. At the Sandhurst Cemetery where the remains were interred, the Rev Pastor Leypoldt conducted the services, and gave an interesting sketch of the deceased gentleman's career. Besides a large number of German residents, most of the leading vignerons of the district were present at the grave.

Mr Oakley conducted the mortuary arrangements.

SURRENDERING A LIFE POLICY.

For many years the late Mr Heinrich Meyer, vigneron of Sheepwash, had his life insured in the Australian Widows and Orphans Fund for £500. He paid his annual fees regularly and never allowed his policy to lapse, and by bonuses the amount of his life assurance accumulated to about £700. On the 17th of last month Mr Meyer, being then in good health, surrendered the policy for £120. On Sunday last he was seized with congestion of the lungs and died on the Monday. Had the policy not been retired the widow and family would have been entitled to draw the whole of the £700.

OBITUARY.

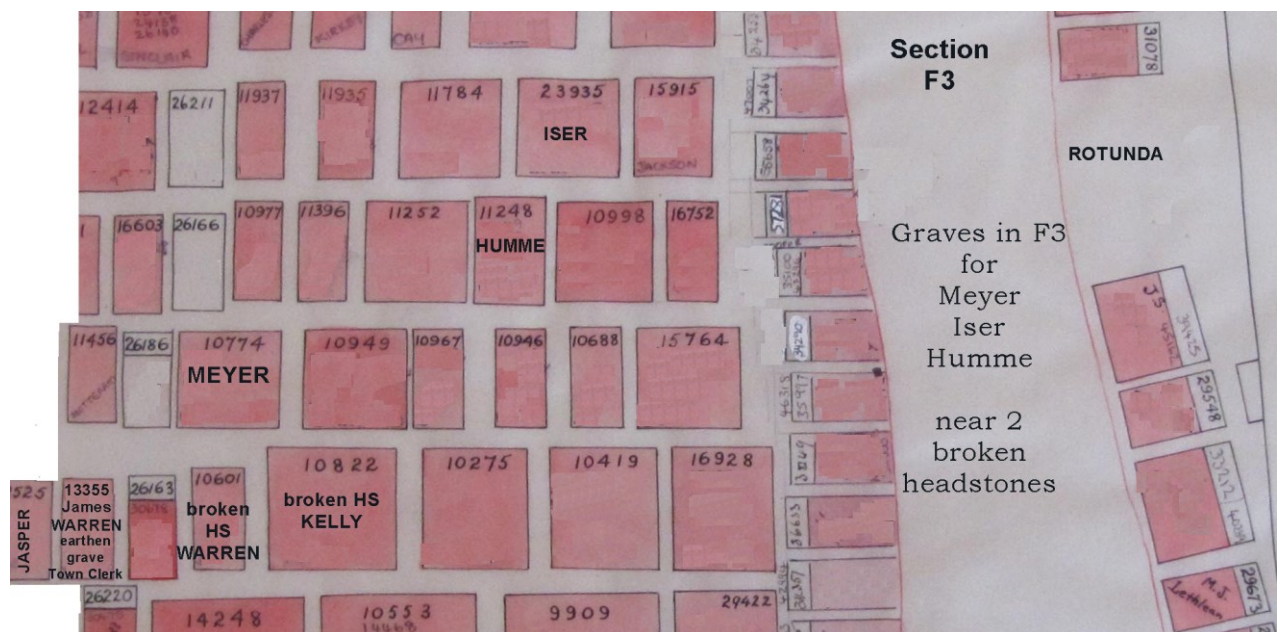
Mr W H Oakley supervised the funeral arrangements.
