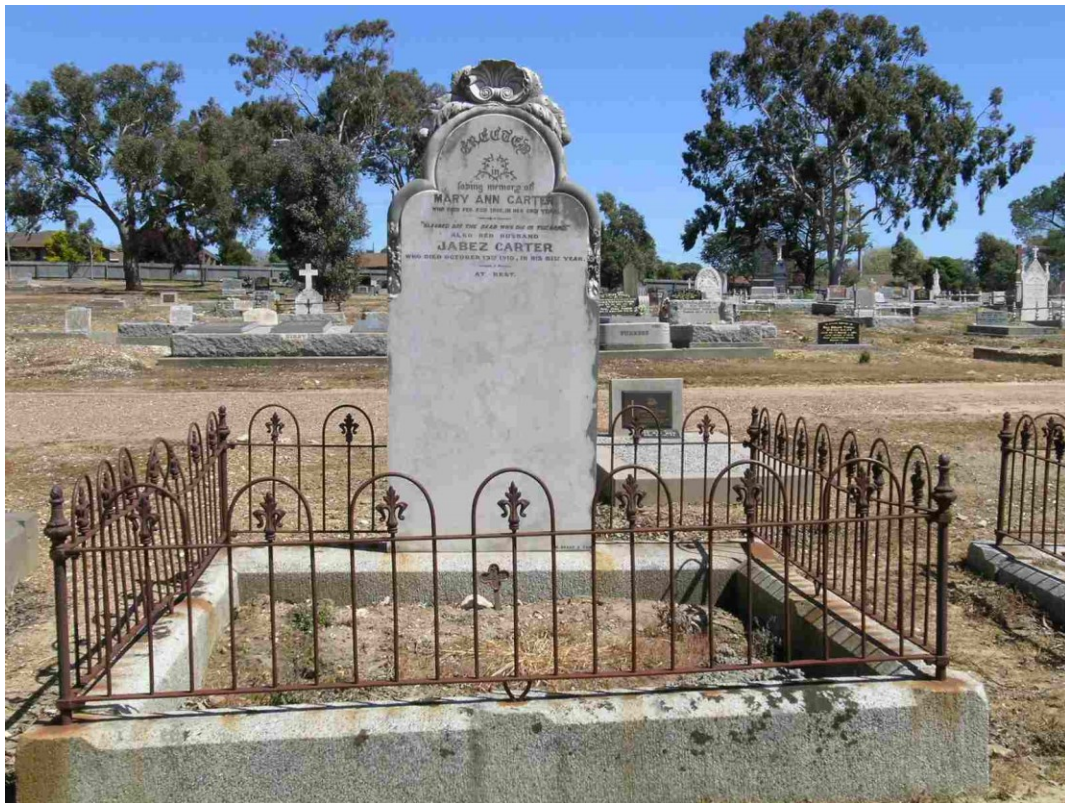


Kangaroo Flat Cemetery



Grave for Jabez & Mary Ann Carter

Some Carter notes:

CARTER -

Jabez Carter was a gold-miner. He was born c1831 at Ruan Minor Cornwall, the son of Richard Carter, a Carpenter, & Christiana Rutter. He died on the 13th October 1910 at Kangaroo Flat aged 80 years.

Jabez married twice, his first marriage took place on the 22nd March 1855 at Sandhurst. Elizabeth Richards had arrived in Victoria c1853. She was born c1834 at Ruan Minor Cornwall, the daughter of Barnard Richards & Elizabeth Drew and died on the 16th of June 1856 at Kangaroo Flat aged 22 yrs and is buried in the Sandhurst Cemetery. *(A record for Elizabeth's burial was not seen in any records.)*

Their only child, Jabez was born on the 24th December 1855 at Maiden Gully.

Jabez Snr remarried in 1871, Mary Ann the relict of James Luxton. Born c1829 daughter of Nicholas Bassett & Ann Bailey, May Ann died on the 23rd February 1888 at Kangaroo Flat aged 59 years.

OBITUARY.

A very old and highly respected resident of Kangaroo Flat, in the person of Mr Jabez Carter, senior, passed away yesterday afternoon at the advanced age of 81 years. The deceased gentleman was born in Cornwall, and was a colonist of 53 years' standing. At one time he was interested in mining, but later on turned his attention to farming pursuits in the Kerang district. In recent years he engaged in orcharding.

Many years ago he married the late Mrs James Luxton, mother of Mr Thomas Luxton, MLC. Mr Carter leaves one son by a former marriage to mourn his loss. The deceased gentleman paid four visits to the old country. The funeral will take place tomorrow to the Kangaroo Flat Cemetery.
