KANGAROO FLAT.
(FROM OUR OWN CORRESPONDENT.)
Friday, 25th March.

Another old and respected resident has joined the majority. Mrs Lewis, of Crusoe, died this afternoon, after an illness of a few hours. She was engaged in her usual domestic duties yesterday morning; in the afternoon she was seized with vomiting, which lasted some time, Dr O'Donnell was called in, but pronounced the case hopeless. The deceased lady was 84 years of age, and leaves, besides her husband, four children, all of whom are married; two sons in Queensland, Mrs Elijah Sutton, of Raywood, and Mrs Edward Silk, of Mount Moliagul. The late Mrs Lewis, with her husband and children, came to the Flat over thirty years ago. She was held in great esteem.
