

Bendigo Cemetery



The Rundle family group were buried in 3 graves in D4 as per cemetery records.

This grave is for Elizabeth Jane and Amy Catherine RUNDLE.

2 sisters, they are buried in grave #755 in section D4.

Elizabeth died in 1861 aged 1 year 9 months per the sandstone headstone.

Amy Catherine died in 1885 aged 14 years but is not named on the headstone.

Their parents were Thomas Turnbull and Elizabeth Charlotte (nee: Webb).

No newspaper record was seen, and Amy is not named on the sandstone headstone.

The 3 RUNDLE graves are in a line, and they include the one with the broken headstone.

The broken headstone is the grave of their parents and two brothers.

The 3rd grave near the road is the grave of their father's brother,

Joseph and his two wives Jane and Elizabeth.
