He died on 26/07/1864 aged 42 years.

The paper states he was a noted "bushmen" and involved with the cattle trade. Probate records list his date of death as 28th Jul 1864 and his occupation as Cattle dealer.

DEATH OF AN OLD BENDIGONIAN.

We regret to have to announce the death of Mr John White, which took place yesterday morning at the Royal Hotel. For the last ten months Mr White has been suffering from disease of the lungs. He will be remembered by the majority of the old residents in the district as being connected with the cattle trade, and as one of the most experienced "bushmen" within a circuit of a hundred miles. Indeed there are few in the district who do not remember the kindly and genial qualities of Jack White, or who will not regret his death.
