The funeral will take place tomorrow to the Bendigo Cemetery.

OBITUARY

The funeral of the late Mr John Stevens took place yesterday, moving from his late residence, Violet Street. The respect in which the deceased gentleman was held was shown by the large attendance of friends who, in addition to his numerous relatives, took part in the lengthy cortege to the Bendigo Cemetery.

The coffin, laden with beautiful white floral emblems, was carried to the grave by Messrs J Wilson, J Gundry, G Pearce, and T Grose. A service was held at the residence and at the grave by the Rev T J Thomas who delivered a brief address, after which the hymn, "There's a land That is Fairer Than Day," was sung by those present. A choice domed immortelle was forwarded by the manager and employees of the New Red White and Blue mine.

The funeral arrangements were carried out by Mr W Farmer, McCrae Street.

LATE MRS JANE STEVENS The funeral of the late Mrs Jane Stevens, widow of John Stevens, late of Violet Street, were yesterday interred in the Church of England section of the Bendigo Cemetery, the funeral cortege moving from the Bendigo Railway Station on arrival of the Melbourne train. The funeral was attended by many friends and relatives. The Rev A P Watsford, of the Methodist Church officiated at the grave and also offered an impressive prayer. Mrs Stevens's husband died 10 years ago.

Mr W Farmer carried out the funeral arrangements.
