



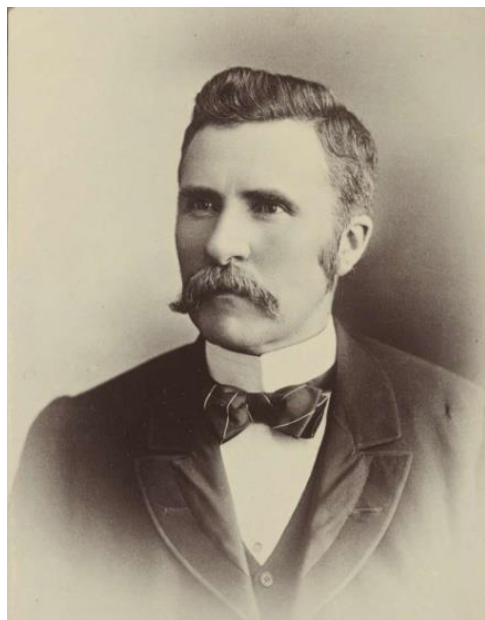

### 19. SIR JOHN QUICK KB, LLD

Born: 14 Apr 1852 St. Ives, Cornwall, England  
Died: 17 June 1932 Camberwell, Victoria, Australia  
Buried: 20 June 1932  
Arrived in Melbourne in 1854

Judge, Barrister, & Doctor of Law. Freemason. Journalist with Bendigo Evening News, Independent, Advertiser & The Age. Member of the Legislative Assembly for Sandhurst (1880-1889); First Federal Member of the House of Representatives for Bendigo (1901-1913); a key proponent, throughout the 1880s and 1890s, of Australian Federation. His knighthood was specifically awarded for his work towards Federation.
